The Borough of Reading (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions) (Shinfield Road) Order 2022

Reading Borough Council under Sections 1(1), 2, 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and under the provisions of Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 has made an Order the effects of which are:

To introduce, remove and amend existing waiting restrictions to allow the progress of Active Travel Tranche 2 on Shinfield Road. This has necessitated changing or revising existing Traffic Orders. The waiting restrictions to be introduced are detailed in the Schedules below:

Schedule 4: No Waiting at Any Time

Beech Road, both sides:

From its junction with Shinfield Road to a point 10m west of that junction.

Devonshire Park, both sides:

From its junction with Shinfield Road to a point 10m east of that junction

Shinfield Road, East sides:

From its junction with Elmhurst Road to its junction with the borough boundary with Wokingham.

Shinfield Road, West side:

From its junction with Elmhurst Road to a point 25m south of its junction with Whitley Wood Road

Shinfield Road, West side

From a point 45m south of its junction with Whitley Wood Road to its borough boundary with Wokingham

Schedule 50: 3hrs limited waiting Mon - Sat 8am-6.30pm No Return Within 1hr

Shinfield Road, West Side:

From a point 25m south of its junction with Whitley Wood Road to a point 45m south of that junction

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act, or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from 12th October 2022 apply for the purpose to the High Court.
