

READING BOROUGH COUNCIL
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 – SECTION 90A BOSTON AVENUE &
SHAW ROAD – TRAFFIC CALMING

NOTICE is hereby given that the Reading Borough Council in consultation with the Police proposes to install traffic calming features as follows:

Boston Avenue

- 1 x Speed hump 12m east of its junction with Shaw Road
- 1 x Speed hump 90m east of its junction with Shaw Road
- 1 x Speed hump 142m east of its junction with Shaw Road
- 1 x Speed hump 212m east of its junction with Shaw Road
- 1 x Speed hump 283m east of its junction with Shaw Road

Shaw Road

- 1 x Speed hump 12m south of its junction with Berkeley Avenue
- 1 x Speed hump 72m south of its junction with Berkeley Avenue
- 1 x Speed hump 137m south of its junction with Berkeley Avenue

All proposed traffic calming measures are of a nominal height of 75mm. All dimensions are approximate and measured to the centre of the speed humps. The traffic calming scheme will reduce vehicle speed, improving road safety in the local area.
