The Reading Borough Council under Sections 1(1), 2, 3, 4, and under Part IV of Schedule 9 and after consultation with the police under Part III of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), proposes to make an order. The effect of the order is to introduce, remove, or vary where necessary the waiting restrictions and parking places as detailed in the schedules below.

Schedule 1:

No stopping Monday – Friday 8am-5pm
on school entrance markings

Church End Lane, East Side:

From a point 12m north east of its junction with Neath Gardens to a point 38m north east of that junction.

Church End Lane, West Side:

From a point 12m north east of its junction with Neath Gardens to a point 38m north east of that junction.

Church End Lane, West Side:

From a point 76m north east of its junction with Neath Gardens to a point 160m north east of that junction.
