The Reading Borough Council under Sections 1(1), 2, 3, 4, and under Part IV of Schedule 9 and after consultation with the police under Part III of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), has made an Order which will come into operation on 13 December 2021.

The effect of the Order is to introduce, remove, or vary where necessary the waiting restrictions and parking places as detailed in the schedules below.

**Schedule 4: No Waiting At Any Time**

**Garrard Street, South Side:**

For its entire length.

**Garrard Street, North Side:**

From its junction with Greyfriars Road to a point 23m west of its junction with Station Road.

**Schedule 10: No Waiting At Any Time Except**  
**Hackney Carriages**

**Garrard Street, North Side:**

From a point 8m west of its junction with Station Road to a point 24m west of that junction.
