

Proludic's proposal for the Ivydene play area has a clear transport theme, given its location. A customised double decker bus is a focal point, and the park features challenging equipment from toddler to juniors split into two distinct progressive areas.

Inclusion for all has been key consideration; elements on the lower deck of the bus can be accessed from side and rear, a petrol pump play panel is specifically positioned at wheelchair accessible height, the pod swing is at a wheelchair transferable height and given its supporting structure assists those with physical and motor disabilities. The park now has two hard surfaced path ways both wide enough to cater for wheelchairs or buggies.

Role play possibilities abound in this park with vehicles, traffic signage and ground floor graphics all adding to the enjoyment that will revitalise the existing area into a park the community can be proud of.

#### Equipment list:-

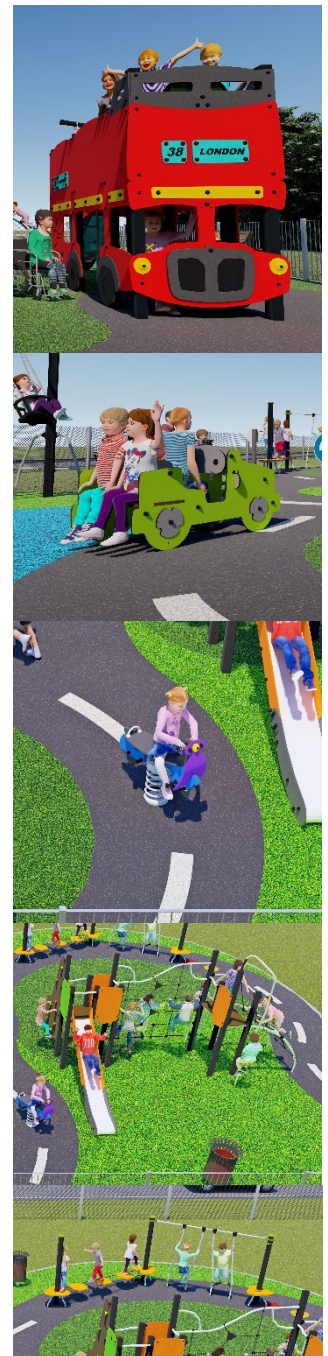
1 x Customised Double-decker Bus -3x Play panels/tactile elements accessible on the lower deck of the bus, a large open area with seating and free space allowing children of all abilities to play together, a drivers seat with steering wheel. This unit offers excellent opportunities for role play and social interaction

1 x 4 person car -Role play opportunities for up to four children seating is accessible with back and arm rests, the height of these allow for easy transfer from a wheel chair, the front seats also have steering wheels for added tactile play

1 x Bike Springer – Offers two children to play together

1 x Junior Multiplay Unit – Designed to offer a wide range of climbing, balancing and hanging activities, the Diabolo's large decks allow many children to play together along with space to allow access for parents and carers. There are four different access points to cater for different levels of ability

1 x Metal Balance Trail – Offers different balancing and traversing activities, it's open design ensure parents and carers can help less able users.

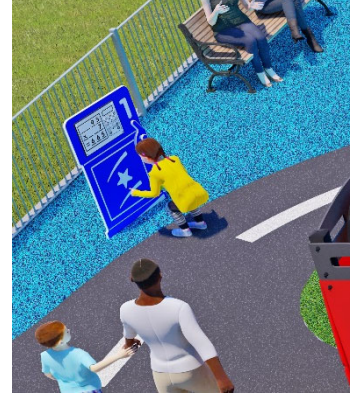


1 x Pod Swing – The largest Pod on the market, sitting at an ideal height for transfer from a wheelchair, the design of the Pod gives an ergonomic comfortable dish for all ages and abilities while it's size ensures as many children as possible can play together.

1 x Petrol Pump Play Panel – Adding to theme of the whole site this play panel is easily accessible to all and further enhances the role playing games of the overall area



2 x Roundabout Street Signs alongside ground-floor graphics – Ground graphics offer games for the children to play with their friends, the street signs ensure there is an opportunity to learn within the area.
