The Borough of Reading (Town Centre Area) (Waiting Restrictions and Movement Control) Order 2000 Amendment No.1

The Borough of Reading (Civil Enforcement Area) (Jacksons Corner) (Waiting Restrictions) Order 202*

Reading Borough Council under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to 3(2), 4(1) and 4(2), 45, 46 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act as amended intends to make the above Orders.

The effect of the amendment Order would be to remove and replace the One-Way traffic restrictions at Schedule 33, from Abbey Square, East to West to Abbey Square – Southwest to Northeast.

The effect of the waiting restrictions order would be to introduce, remove or amend existing waiting restrictions and parking places.

No Stopping At Any Time (Red Route)

King's Road, north side

From a point 19m east of its junction with Abbey Square to a point 30m west of that junction

King's Road, north side

From a point 43m west of its junction with Abbey Square to its junction with High Street

No Stopping Except Motorcycles, At Any Time (Red Route)

King's Road, north side

From a point 39m east of its junction with Abbey Square to a point 50m east of that junction

No Stopping Except Disabled Badge Holders At Any Time, 4 Hours, Return Prohibited Within 2 Hours. (Red Route)

King's Road, north side

From a point 19m east of its junction with Abbey Square to a point 39m east of that junction

No Stopping Except Loading Or Unloading Only, 11am to 4pm and 7pm to 7am, Maximum Stay 20 Minutes. At all other times buses only (Red Route)

King's Road, north side

From a point 30m west of its junction with Abbey Square to a point 43m west of that junction

No Waiting At Any Time Except Disabled Badge Holders, 4 Hours, Return Prohibited Within 2 Hours

Abbey Square, south side

From a point 40m northeast of its junction with King's Road to a point 12m east of that point

Loading Only At Any Time. Maximum Stay 40 min

Abbey Square, west side

From a point 14m north of its junction with King's Road to a point 12m north of that point
