THE BOROUGH OF READING
(KINGS ROAD)
(BUS LANE) ORDER 2024

Reading Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4 and Part III of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (“the Act”), the Traffic Management Act 2004 as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 2004”), and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act as amended intends to make the above order. The effect of this order will be to prohibit vehicles except buses, cycles, motorcycles and authorised vehicles only in the length of roads as per below::

Kings Road, eastbound

From a point 7 metres west of its junction with Forbury Road eastwards to the western kerb line extension of its junction with Forbury Road.

Kings Road, eastbound

The area of carriageway of that length of Kings Road which extends from a point 9m east of the east side of the junction with Forbury Road for a distance of 190m.

Kings Road, eastbound

The area of carriageway of that length of Kings Road which extends from a point 8m east of the east side of the junction with Orts Road to a point 44m west of its junction with Amity Road.
