(SILCHESTER ROAD AND FAIRCROSS ROAD)
(ONE-WAY) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2019

Reading Borough Council under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposes to make an Order the effect of which is to introduce a one-way restriction on:

Road	Direction
Silchester Road Between its junction with Faircross Road and Circuit Lane	East to West
Faircross Road Between its junction with Southcote Lane and Silchester Road	North to South

The following restrictions contained in the Borough of Reading (Bath Road Area) Order 1994 will be revoked:

Fifth Schedule – No Right Turn

Faircross Road to Southcote Lane

Southcote Lane to Faircross Road

Sixth Schedule – One Way Traffic

Item 3, Faircross Road, South to North,

Item 4, Silchester Road, South-West to North-East
