

**THE BOROUGH OF READING (SCHOOL STREET) (HARLEY ROAD)
(PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES)
ORDER 2022**

**NOTICE OF MAKING EXPERIMENTAL ORDER
PERMANENT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Reading Borough Council on 20th July 2022 pursuant to its powers under 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(1) and Part IV of schedule 9 to The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Regulation 23 of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 as amended and of all other enabling powers.

The effect of the order will be to continue in force indefinitely the provisions of The Borough of Reading (School Street) (Harley Road) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) (Experimental) (Variation No.1) Order 2021 and prohibit any motor vehicle, except eligible vehicles as agreed by Reading Borough Council, to enter into or proceed in the full length of Harley Road from 8.15am - 9.15am and 2.40 - 3.40pm Monday to Friday term time only. Harley Road shall become a Pedestrian and cycle zone.

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provision on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act, or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from 20th July 2022 apply for the purpose to the High Court.
