The Borough of Reading (Civil Enforcement Area) (Pay and Display) (Wokingham Road) Order 2020

Reading Borough Council under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32, 35, 45 and 46, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended intends to make an Order the effects of which are:

To introduce pay and display parking places either in the interests of safety or in response to demand. This has necessitated changing or revising existing Traffic Orders.

Schedule: Resident permit holders only or pay & display, Mon-Sun 24hrs

Wokingham Road, southwest side

From a point 20 metres southeast of its junction Green Road to a point 55 metres southeast of that junction

Wokingham Road, southwest side

From a point 30 metres southeast of its junction with Talfourd Avenue to a point 45 metres southeast of that point

Wokingham Road, southwest side

From a point 10 metres south of its junction with Melrose Avenue to a point 105 metres south of that point

Wokingham Road, northeast side

From a point 33 metres northwest of its junction with Talfourd Avenue to a point 110 metres southeast of that point

Wokingham Road, east side

From a point 10 metres north of its junction with Brackendale Way to a point 80 metres north of that point

Wokingham Road, east side

From a point 10 metres south of its junction with Brackendale Way to a point 70 metres south of that point

Wokingham Road, southwest side

From a point 12 metres south of its junction Belle Avenue to a point 55 metres south of that point

Wokingham Road, east side

From a point 10 metres south of its junction with Heath Road to a point 55 metres southeast of that point

Tariff:

Up to 2hrs: Free

3hrs: 50p

4hrs: £1

Each additional hour (or part, thereof): +50p
